

through Thursday, August 2.


If you have items to donate, but no way to get

Kimberly Myers is the founder and president of Heart of Christ International. She is a cross-cultural leader and facilitator within the Body of Christ. Her passion is to train and equip believers in the rural areas of the nations to do the work of ministry. She leads teams into the nations to equip leaders and the saints they serve through healing schools and a variety of other ministry opportunities. People encounter the love of God demonstrated powerfully through healings, miracles, signs and wonders.

This past year Kimberly has led eight teams into the nations of South Africa, Ethiopia, and Mexico. The next several months they will return to these nations and travel to at least five additional countries. Their ministry consists largely of conferences and workshops providing biblical tools and training in their use in ministering the gospel like Jesus. They have seen many come to faith in Christ as He reveals His goodness through healings, miracles and deliverances.

She will share with you about believers of all ages laying hands on the sick, and the power of God present to heal the blind, the deaf, the mute and many more. She will tell you about Santa Rosa, a town once totally controlled by witchcraft. And she will inspire you with her passion to assist others in the discovery of their original, created, value.

Kimberly served many years in the local church here in Sedalia. She obtained formal training for spiritual leadership as well as practical training and mentorship, at Antioch Fellowship, under apostle Harvey Miller and pastor Steve Graff, before answering the call to foreign missions. In addition to various short term missions in the US and abroad, she has served long term with Iris Global Ministries in Dondo, Mozambique and established a missions base in the rural mountains of Niigata, Japan. She has also trained under Global Awakening, founded by Dr. Randy Clark, in Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania, and is currently pursuing an undergraduate degree in Biblical studies. She holds ministerial credentials with the Apostolic Network of Global Awakening (ANGA) and works in relationship with Global Awakening to equip and train their ministry school students and alumni with practical cross-cultural
